- Riders must wear protective headgear at all times while mounted. No exceptions.
- Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or divide any class if entries warrant.
- Prize money subject to change if number of entries is less than 10.
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- No longeing in show or schooling arenas.
- Entries close the Wednesday before each show. Post entry will incur a \$25 fee.
- Entries may be mailed, faxed, or submitted through www.horseshowing.com
- Horse show to follow current USEF regulations, including biosecurity, unless otherwise stated.
- All riders, including non-competing, must complete a release form.
- Back numbers will not be released without signed release form and form of payment.
- \$50 for non showing horses.

STABLING

- Stabling requests must be received by the horseshow office one week prior to the start of each show to be guaranteed.
- Stalls are permanent or temporary with doors.
- Stalls are \$50 per day.
- Payment must be received to guarantee stabling requests.
- Bedding is not provided, but is available for purchase

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2016 Biosecurity Protocols / Statement of Health

Hudson Valley Show Jumping is dedicated to the health, welfare and safety of all exhibitors both equine and human. To protect our equine partners, we will be enforcing the following protocols at all Hudson Valley Show Jumping horse shows. A current (within 12 months) negative Coggins test is required.

Proof of Vaccinations (per the USEF GR-845 Equine Vaccination Rule [CHAPTER 8F Welfare of the Horse] Rule Changes Effective 12/1/15)

At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.

In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee.

Any horse on the show grounds with a fever of unknown origin or of suspicious origin must be reported to Show Management. It is always better to err on the side of safety. Isolation stalls will either be available on the grounds or at a local veterinary practice if the need arises.

Please take the time to review equine good hygiene practices. Please convey the importance of this to your equine caretakers for their daily routines.

By signing below, I testify that the horse listed on this entry has: 1) Been enrolled in a regular and consistent program of vaccination against EHV-4/1 with the most recent booster being within 120 days. 2) Has not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days. 3) Has not been exposed to any horse or ponies that have been treated for or shown symptoms of EHV 4/1 within the past 28 days. 4) Has not had a temperature greater than 100.5 in the last 28 days.
